Reporting - sharing students learning

For a number of years Communicating Student Learning has incorporated a student perspective. This is a very interesting component for me to read.

Except for the youngest grades where the comments are scribed most of the student comments are input with the students creative spelling and sentence structure. Of course there are teacher prompts to help your child share their learning experiences.

Report cards are written using MyEd a program supported by the Ministry of Education. We have discovered a few formatting issues that may cause confusion or simply make the report a bit clunky:

- First “term 2” precedes the teacher comments in every section this a format issue that we can not alter.
- Second and more importantly teachers report on Literacy, Numeracy and Learning Habits every term. The other subjects are reported on once or twice a year depending on subject and student grade.
Unfortunately MyEd has all the subject appearing whether they are being reported on or not.
