Tsawwassen First Nation Treaty

April 3rd marks the 15th Anniversary of the First Urban Treaty in BC. The Tsawwassen First Nation Final agreement (the Treaty) is a tripartite agreement between Canada, British Columbia, and the Tsawwassen First Nation. It is a comprehensive agreement that provides for the transfer of land and self-government jurisdiction to Tsawassen First Nation (TFN.) This is a major shift in the relationship between Tsawwassen First Nations, Canada and British Columbia, and various tools that allows TFN to succeed as a self-governing First Nation. The treaty was effective on April 3, 2009. Tsawwassen First Nation was the first in BC to achieve a treaty under the BC treaty process.
