Tips for Finding Success Heading back to School

Here are some suggestions that will be helpful in establishing school routines and will make this year the most successful one yet for your child!

01

READING ROUTINE

Carve out a bit of time each day to read with your child. You can read to them, you can share the reading, or even read alongside them.

Need book suggestions? Talk to your child's teacher!

02

THE POWER OF PLAY

Giving your child daily opportunities for unstructured play (away from screens) helps build resilience, creativity, imagination, problemsolving abilities and social skills.

Examples of unstructured play include: building objects, art activities, imagined/made-up games and time at the park.

03

THE SECRET OF SLEEP

(It's actually not a secret.)

Sleep is a significant factor in school success. School aged kids should be getting 9 to 11 hours of quality sleep per night to improve focus, reduce tricky behaviours, and give the body and brain time to grow and develop.

04

TREASURED TALK TIME

Spend a bit of time each day in focussed conversation with your child about their learning. Ask specific questions that will require explanation. The educational and relational benefits of this are immense!

05

CONNECT WITH CLIFF DRIVE

The importance of a positive home-school relationship cannot be overstated! Get to know your child's teacher(s) and keep them informed of factors that may be affecting your child at school. Speak positively and supportively about your child's teacher at home and make sure your child knows that you are interested in his/her school. This will send the message that what he/she is doing is important.
